In line with the Ministry of Christ United Church, each team participating in a C-Sports sponsored or related sport is asked to perform at least one service project during their season. Players, coaches, and even family members may participate and are encouraged to wear their jerseys unless the nature of the project would likely damage them (painting, etc.). All service projects ideas should to be approved in advance prior to communicating to families. The coach or team parent is asked to fill out this form and turn it in to the Director of Recreation Ministry upon the completion of the project.

Choosing a project where the children are working with their hands and feet to serve is suggested. If this is not possible, we strongly encourage them to make their service project to include and focus on teaching the children to serve with their hands and feet to “earn the money” for those items. Parents can create a work/chore list for how much they can earn by doing a task as a team. Service opportunities ideas include but are not limited to: Litter patrol around this or other churches, parks, beach, etc., helping a senior citizen clean their yard, serve as greeters at a church service, adopt a cleaning project in the recreation area, free car wash, making cookies for a nursing home, make a gift box for a soldier overseas, clean up after a C-Sports game, as well as volunteering to help specific CU Ministries such as Grounds Ministry and Lifegate. Teaching them to do a project together where they all pitch in to help each other help others is key. Also, please be aware that families in our program have differing levels of income. Some have more than one child in the program. Each family pays a registration fee to be in the program. Asking for more money, whether for a team party, coach’s gift, or service project is discouraged.
